1. World Environment Day (05 June, 2024)

नारला कालेज में एनसीसी यूनिट ने मनाया योग दिवस



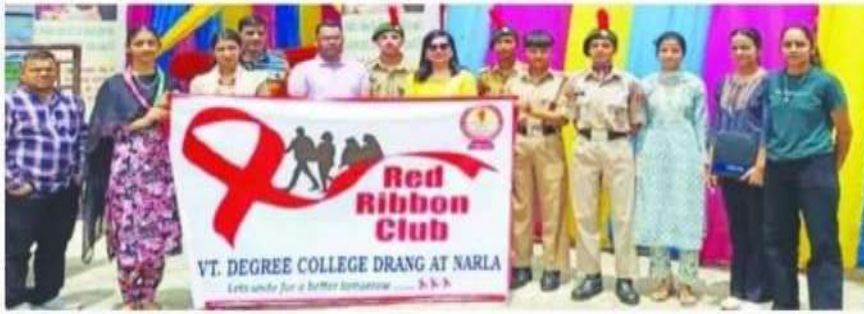

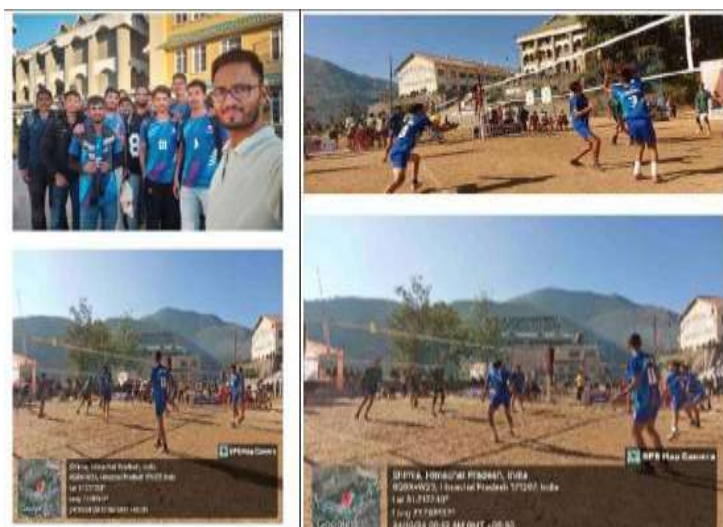
18. Inter-college volleyball- Women's (15-17 October, 2024)

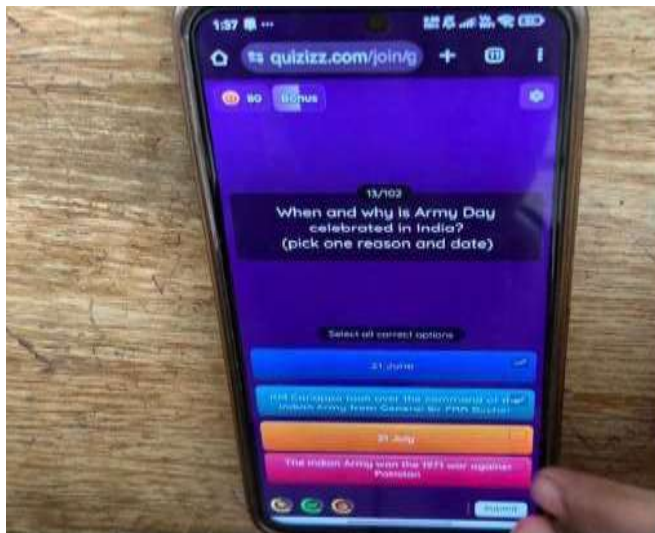
22. Poster Making Competition and Cleanliness Drive (23 November, 2024)

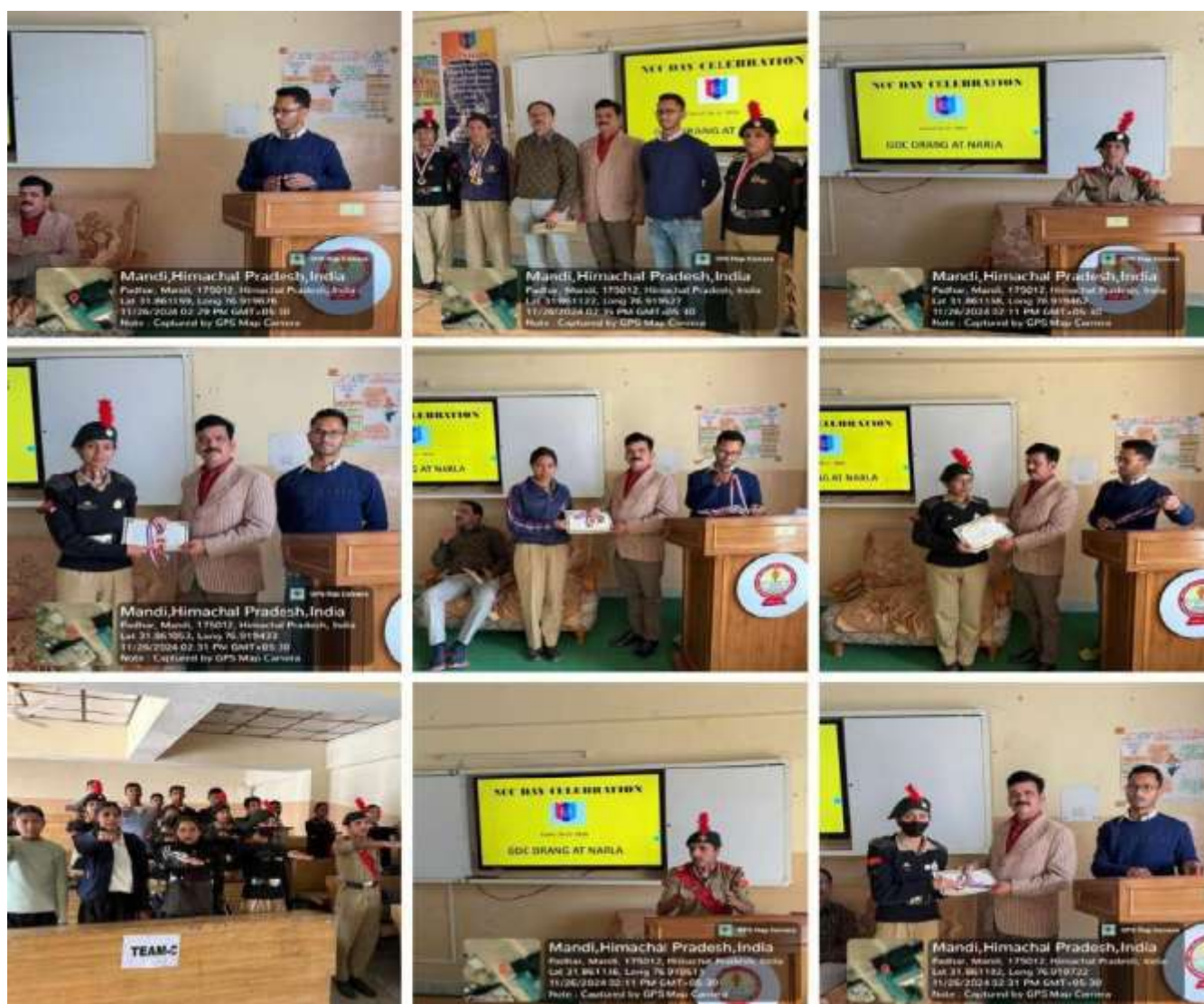
23. Online Quiz Related to NCC (26 November, 2024)

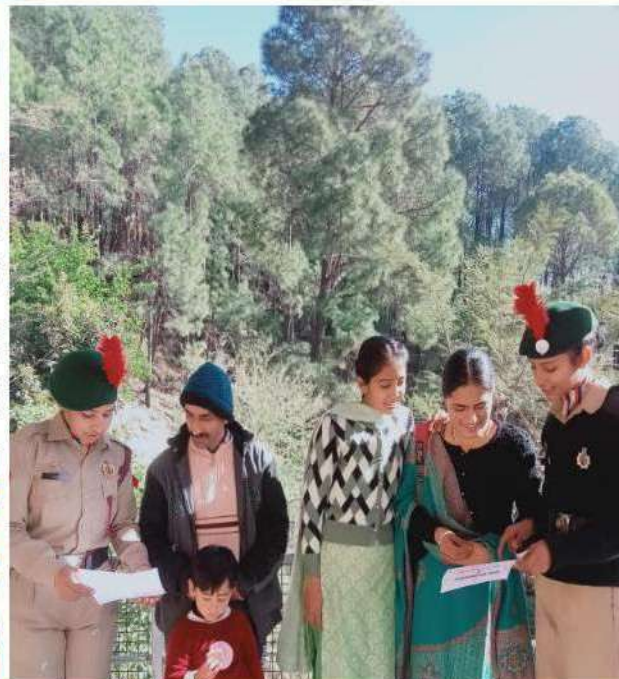

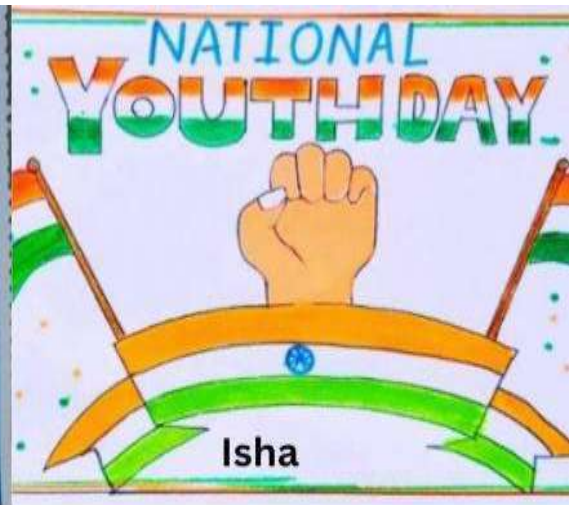
28. Inter-College Shooting Men/Women (17-19 December, 2024)

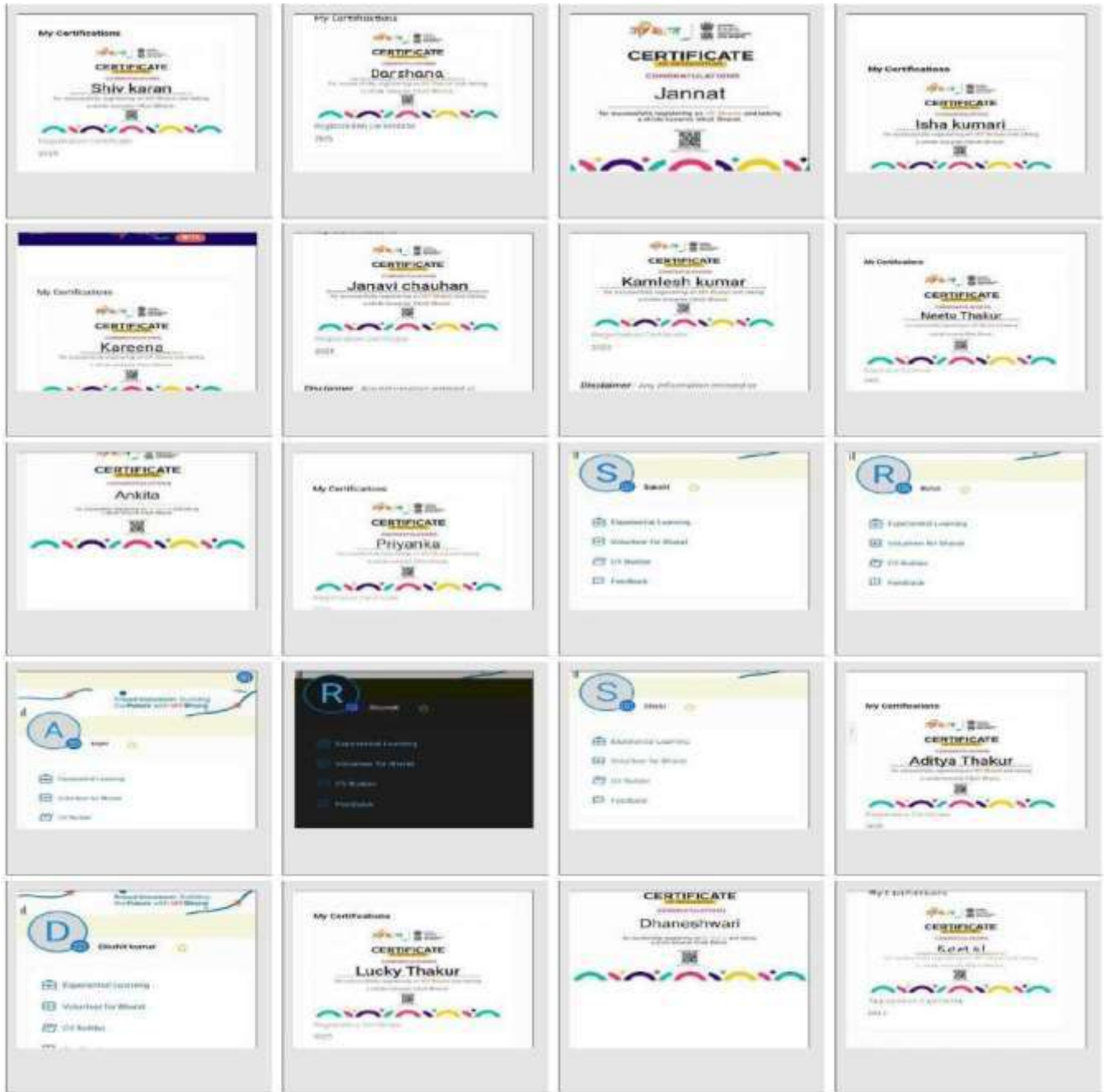


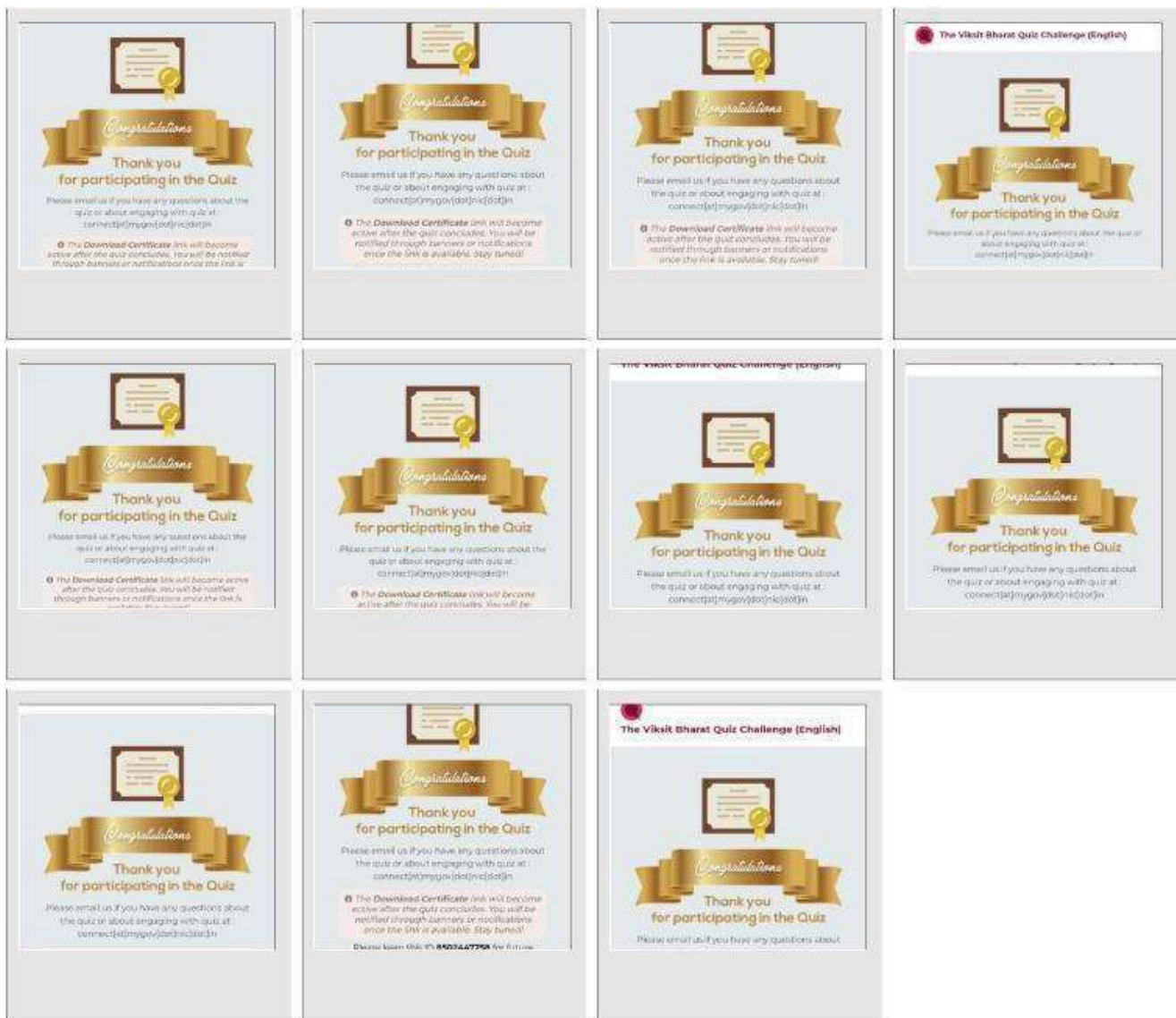
