1. Institutional Profile

GDC Drang at Narla Mandi is a government-funded higher education institution offering undergraduate programmes primarily in Arts, Commerce, and Science streams. The college caters mainly to students from rural and semi-rural backgrounds.

2. Academic Programmes

- **Undergraduate Programmes:**
 - B.A. (Humanities)
 - B.Sc. (Science)
 - B.Com. (Commerce)
- **Curriculum:**
 - Prescribed by Sardar Patel University
 - Periodically updated as per SPU and UGC guidelines

Audit Observation:

Curriculum delivery aligns with university norms, but scope exists for **value-added and skill-based courses**.

3. Teaching–Learning Process

- Qualified faculty appointed as per UGC and State Government norms
- Use of traditional classroom teaching with gradual integration of ICT tools
- Internal assessment conducted through tests, assignments, and presentations

Strengths

- Student–teacher interaction is satisfactory
- Teachers focus on syllabus completion and exam preparedness

Areas for Improvement

- Increased use of digital tools (LMS, smart classrooms)
- Adoption of learner-centric and experiential teaching methods

4. Faculty Profile and Development

- Permanent and contractual faculty members
- Participation in FDPs, conferences, workshops, and seminars encouraged

Audit Observation:

More institutional support is needed for **research, publications, and innovation.**

5. Student Performance and Evaluation

- Semester examinations conducted by SPU
- Internal assessment transparency maintained

Concerns

- Variation in pass percentages across programmes
- Limited structured mentoring for slow learners

6. Student Support and Progression

- Scholarships provided as per government schemes
- Career guidance and counselling available on a limited scale

Recommendations

- Strengthen career guidance and placement initiatives
- Organize regular competitive exam coaching and skill workshops

7. Infrastructure and Learning Resources

- Adequate classrooms and basic laboratory facilities

- Library with textbooks and reference materials

Gaps Identified

- Need for more updated reference books and e-resources
- Expansion of ICT and internet-enabled learning spaces

8. Governance and Quality Assurance

- College administration functions under Directorate of Higher Education, HP
- IQAC either established or in process (to be strengthened)

Audit Recommendation

- Regular academic and administrative audits
- Systematic documentation of best practices

- Research culture
