1. Shooting Trial By Old Student (Kiran Rawat) August 28, 2025

A special practice session for pistol players was organized at GDC Drang at Narla, under the banner of the Old Students' Association (OSA) in preparation for the inter-college shooting competition. The session was conducted by alumna and shooter Kiran Rawat, who guided the players on fundamental techniques, including aiming, body stability, breath control, weapon handling, and maintaining concentration, while also emphasizing mental balance, discipline, and consistent practice. The players participated enthusiastically, clarified their doubts, and expressed that such training would motivate them for better performance in the upcoming competition. The program was successfully managed by Prof. Hukam Chand, Games In-Charge, who encouraged the players to work hard and maintain regular practice.



2. Lecture on “Right to Privacy in the Digital Age and Social Media” August 28, 2025

A special lecture was organized at GDC Drang at Narla, under the aegis of the Old Students' Association. On this occasion, alumna Himani, a final-year law student, engaged with the students on the topic “Right to Privacy in the Digital Age and Social Media.” In her lecture, Himani highlighted that social media has become an integral part of modern life. While it serves as a vital medium of expression, it also poses significant risks to personal privacy. She informed students about the importance of the right to privacy under the Constitution, particularly under

Article 21, and elaborated on current legal frameworks related to digital privacy, including the Information Technology Act and recent guidelines. To make the session more engaging, Himani conducted an interactive discussion with the students, where they inquired about protecting themselves from cybercrimes and precautions to take when sharing personal information on social media. Using practical examples, she demonstrated how even small lapses can lead to serious issues. Principal Dr. Kalyan Chand Mandhotra remarked that such lectures help students become aware of digital citizenship and understand their rights and responsibilities. He appreciated Himani's efforts, noting that it is a matter of pride that an alumna of the college is providing guidance on such an important topic to the society today.

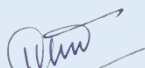

महत्वपूर्ण व्याख्यान का आयोजन किया गया। इस कार्यक्रम में महाविद्यालय की पूर्व छात्रा एवं वर्तमान में विधि की अंतिम वर्ष की छात्रा हिमानी ने डिजिटल युग में निजता का अधिकार और सोशल मीडिया विषय पर छात्रों को जागरूक करते हुए संवाद स्थापित किया। हिमानी ने अपने व्याख्यान में बताया कि आजकल सोशल मीडिया हमारे जीवन का एक अभिन्न अंग बन चुका है, जो अभिव्यक्ति का प्रमुख माध्यम होने के साथ-साथ व्यक्ति की निजता के लिए गंभीर चुनौतियां भी लेकर आया है। उन्होंने बताया कि संविधान में प्रदत्त मौलिक अधिकारों में अनुच्छेद 21 के तहत निजता का अधिकार अत्यंत महत्वपूर्ण है, जिसे डिजिटल युग में विशेष रूप से संरक्षित किया जाना आवश्यक है। उन्होंने छात्रों को सूचना प्रौद्योगिकी अधिनियम सहित डिजिटल प्राइवैसी से जुड़े वर्तमान कानूनों और हाल ही में जारी किए गए दिशानिर्देशों से अवगत कराया। हिमानी ने सोशल मीडिया के उपयोग के दौरान सतर्कता बरतने की सलाह दी और बताया कि किस प्रकार साइबर अपराधों से बचा जा सकता है। कभी-कभी छोटी-सी लापरवाही भी व्यक्तिगत एवं कानूनी समस्याओं का कारण बन सकती है।
